

Multi-Engine Training Endorsement



Once instructors have gained the 50(+) hours flight time on a multi-engine aircraft, a popular pathway in gaining multi experience is the Multi Engine Training Endorsement.

The course will cover all the theory aspects of flying a twin, including recognition, control and performance, asymmetric handling, engine failure decision making. Competency must be achieved in both briefing delivery and in flight, replicating the initial multi-engine class rating syllabus.

- BE76/PA44 Flight Test Rental
- Flight Examiner fees

Training and Experience Requirements

- Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) or Air Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL)
- Current Australian Instructor Rating
- Grade 2 instructor Endorsement
- Aircraft class rating for the specified class
- At least 50 hours (Including 10 PIC) of aeronautical experience as a pilot of an aircraft of the specified class.
