



Private Pilot Licence

PPL is the next step. This licence will allow you to fly friends and family anywhere in Australia during the day in visual conditions. In this course you will build on the basics you have already mastered and be taught how to navigate. The theory component culminates with a CASA cyber exam which we can help you prepare for. Once you have passed the flight test you will be "free" to fly where ever you choose!

All training is done in a Cessna 172 or a Piper PA-28.

Licence Requirements

- Be at least 17 years of age.
- Complete flight training at a CASR Part 141 organisation.
- Pass a PPL theory exam.
- Pass a PPL flight test for the licence and category rating.
- If over 18, hold a current aviation security status check.

Training for a PPL requires at least 40 hours of flying time, including:

- 5 hours of general flight time as pilot in command.
- 5 hours of cross country flight time as pilot in command.
- 2 hours of instrument flight time.

Medical Requirements

- CASA Class 1 or 2 Medical (conducted by a Designated Aviation Medical Examiner (DAME), and permits carriage of more than one passenger.
